Build a Drum Workshop October 27-29, 2017

Camp Mack has partnered with Stan Secrest, an expert drum builder, artist and teacher to bring an outstanding weekend drum building workshop to Indiana. Come use your creative skills to build your very own custom drum that will bring you years of enjoyment.

The **time required** depends on the style and type of drum you choose to build. An average drum takes about 16 hours to build. It helps if you have design ideas upon arrival.

The steps and a basic time line are:

Sanding	1 hr.

- ☐ Decorating and staining 2-6 hrs plus drying time
- □ Preparing the rings□ Preparing the skin1-2 hrs
- \Box Preparing the skin 1-2 hrs \Box Lacing the drum 3-5 hrs
- ☐ Final detailing 1 hr

Total Hrs 14-16

This workshop is designed as group instruction as there will not be continual one-on-one instruction. The fun comes in helping each other through the learning process. Stan is always nearby in case you need assistance. Camp Mack also provides a wonderful place to take breaks during your weekend. Walk by the lake, meditate in the chapel or woods, and relax as you jam with other drum builders.

Who can build a drum?

There are children and youth drums available. See the special one day youth drum option that is designed specifically for kids ages 6-12. For the regular workshop, we recommend ages 12 and up. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.



Flexible Scheduling

There are several options available to help meet the needs of folk's busy schedules. You may pick from overnight or day use. Come early for more individualized attention. Again this year, we are offering a one day kid's special youth drum building.

- 1. Friday 7 pm through Sunday at 5 pm (overnight with food service)
- 2. Same time as above expect day use only (Meals optional)
- 3. **Kids' Day Package:** For kids ages 6+ Saturday 9 am-4 pm: Kids' Day is \$40 and includes lunch for both parent and child. Cost of drum for a Youth Octagonal Ashiko drum is extra.

Lodging:

Overnight attendees will stay in the Ulrich House. Dormitory style lodging. You will share lodging with others of your same gender. Please bring your own bedding; linens may be rented for \$8.00.

How do I choose a Drum?

Take a few moments and explore the drum styles and choices listed below. The drum that is right for you is based on how much work and time you wish to put into it, your preference in style and the cost that is suitable for you. The cost for 2 night and 5 meals is \$112.00 plus the cost of your drum.

The day rate is \$18.00 per day and you may sign up for meals *plus* the cost of your drum.

Kids Day is \$36 for adult and child including lunch plus the cost of your drum. Choice of:
