

Camper/Leader Internet Contact Policy

We recognize that:

- Campers and counselors develop close, trusting relationships with one another at camp and that these relationships can be healthy, wholesome, and beneficial to campers and staff alike.
- It is natural for campers to want to keep in touch with their favorite counselors from camp.
- For some campers the counselors may be from their own congregation.

As a camp we do not encourage the exchange of Internet information between campers and staff, whether paid or volunteer, nor do we take the responsibility for what may occur as a result of such contact.

If a parent or legal guardian wishes their child to exchange such information with a camp leader, the parent or legal guardian must sign this form expressly granting this permission and accepting full responsibility for whatever may occur as a result.

PERSONAL CONDUCT- Church camp is about living in Christian community. In an attempt to provide an atmosphere where children can live together in the community, the campers are expected to: participate and cooperate in activities, respect one another, use no profanity, wear modest and appropriate clothing, and have behavior that is not disruptive to the program. The camp reserves the right to send home a camper who is unable to function within these guidelines.

In signing this, I certify that all information provided during registration and all forms is correct and my child/ward is in good health and may participate in camping activities. Should it become necessary for him/her to return home during the week because of illness, accident, homesickness, or conduct, I will abide by the camp's decision in this matter and provide transportation.

I recognize that certain hazards and dangers are inherent in camp events and programs. I understand, also, that although the camp has taken precaution to provide proper supervision instruction, training, and equipment for each activity, it is impossible for the camp to guarantee absolute safety. I further understand that my child/ward shares responsibility for his/her safety and I have instructed my child/ward in the importance of knowing and abiding by camp rules, regulations, and procedures for the safety of the camp participant.

Further, I waive any claim that may arise against the camp and/or employees as a result of participation in the program, except for those that are a direct result of gross negligence of the camp or its employees.
