

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1) Must have completed 10th grade and/or be at least 16 years old.
- 2) Must attend leadership training session(s) prior to camp.
- 3) A desire to know Jesus Christ better and God's plan for his or her own life and the need to share his or her quest with others.
- 4) An appreciation for the natural world God has given us and of our stewardship of it.
- 5) Be a team player and open to group action and have the ability to take a leadership role in a small group.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Each counselor-in-training is directly responsible to his or her counselor at all times.
- 2) Indirectly responsible to the weekly Team Leaders.
- 3) Indirectly responsible to the Program Director.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Assist the Counselor in the cabin or small group.
- 2) Assist the Counselor in the groups' planning of the week's program.
- 3) Reflect the Summer Camping Objectives in all activities.
- 4) Interpret safety and health regulations.
- 5) Be familiar with the policies of Camp Mack.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Live with a group of four to eight campers and help each camper
- 2) Guide the individual camper in participation in group, unit and all-camp activities.
- 3) Assist with the program activities and other activities in the unit working closely with the counselor.
- 4) Assist with all camp program activities and other camp-wide activities as assigned.
- 5) Assume leadership of the group as requested by counselor.
- 6) Shall be with the campers at all times except at periods of free time to be scheduled with the counselor.
- 7) Submit to the Team Leaders a written evaluation of the week using the evaluation form in the appendix prior to leaving the camp.
- 8) Participate in daily training sessions as offered.

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
